The Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control (DWMRC) is proposing to approve a Class 3 permit modification request to update the Corrective Action Program at the Tooele Army Depot South Area (TEAD-S). TEAD-S submitted the modification request on January 23, 2020. This modification adds new Post-Closure Plans to the Permit for Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) going into post-closure; makes administrative changes to existing Post-Closure Permits to update references to the Utah Administrative Code; and removes closed Areas of Concern (AOCs) that met risk-based closure. A draft of the modified permit has been prepared and is available for public comment.

The public comment period to receive comments on the draft approval will commence on April 24, 2020, and end on June 8, 2020.
