On March 30, 2023, the Utah Test and Training Range (UTTR) submitted an application to renew their RCRA Part B Operating Permit which was due to expire on September 27, 2023. In evaluating UTTR's permit renewal application, the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control (Division) considered progress made on the remediation of the former hazardous waste landfill, Landfill 5. The Division worked closely with the U.S. EPA on open burn and open detonation alternative technology considerations. Based on this evaluation, the Division has prepared a Draft of the new RCRA Part B Permit.

A 45-day public comment period to receive comments on the draft permit will commence on Thursday, December 28, 2023, and end at 5:00 pm on Monday, February 12, 2024.

A public hearing will be held at 5:00 pm on Monday, January 22, 2024, at the Utah Department of Environmental Quality (Multi-Agency State Office Building) Conference Room #1015, located at 195 North 1950 West, Salt Lake City, Utah.
