DAVIS CLASS I LANDFILL**

Wasatch Integrated Waste Management District has submitted an application for a permit renewal for the Davis Class I landfill located at 1997 East 3500 North in Layton, Utah. The proposed permit application for renewal of the Class I landfill has been reviewed and determined to be complete and in compliance with the Utah Solid Waste Permitting and Management Rules. This permit renewal allows the facility to continue to operate the Davis Class I landfill for ten years after the permit renewal has been approved. The public comment period for the draft permit begins on July 2, 2019 and ends on July 31, 2019.
