NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT
WAYNE COUNTY LONG HOLLOW CLASS II LANDFILL

The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control is seeking public comment on an application to renew the Wayne County Long Hollow Class II Landfill Permit. The landfill is located approximately four miles Southwest of Loa, Utah on two-hundred acres in what is known as Long Hollow. The landfill is permitted to accept municipal solid waste, non-hazardous industrial waste, commercial waste, dead animals, and white goods, scrap metal, tires, yard waste, construction/demolition waste and non-friable asbestos.

The permit renewal application has been reviewed and determined to be complete and compliant with the Utah Solid Waste Permitting and Management Rules. A draft permit has been prepared. The public comment period for the draft permit begins on August 20, 2015 and ends September 18, 2015.

All documents included with comments should be submitted as ASCII (text) files or in pdf format.

Under Utah Code Section 19-1-301.5, a person who wishes to challenge a Permit Order may only raise an issue or argument during an adjudicatory proceeding that was raised during the public comment period and was supported with sufficient information or documentation to enable the Director to fully consider the substance and significance of the issue.
