NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT
Weber Valley Multi-use Youth Center
Draft Site Management Plan

The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control is seeking public comment on a draft Site Management Plan for the Weber Valley Multi-Use Youth Center located at 707 West 12th Street Ogden, Utah.

In preparation for construction of the Youth Center, contaminated soils have been removed from the site. However, concentrations of polyaromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs) remaining in the soil disqualify the site for unrestricted use. While there is no significant human health or environmental risk based on the planned future use of the site, the draft Site Management Plan will ensure controls are in place to mitigate any risk due to the presence of PAHs.

The public comment period on the draft Site Management Plan will begin March 10, 2017 and end April 10, 2017. Documents related to this draft Site Management Plan can be reviewed at the following location:
