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Stringency Designations of Final Rule Components

More Stringent:

- SQG re-notification every 4 years (R315-262-18)
- Generators must ID hazards of wastes being accumulated & label properly (throughout the rules)
- LQG must provide notification of closure to the Director (R315-262-17)
- Biennial reporting for the whole year, not just the months the generator was an LQG. (R315-261-41)
- Biennial reporting by Recyclers (SQG/LQG) Who Don't Store (R315-261-6)
- Quick Reference Guide for Contingency Plans (R315-262-262)
- LQGs accumulating hazardous waste in containers that cannot meet closure performance standards must close as a landfill.(R315-262-17(a)(8))

Less Stringent

- Very Small Quantity Generator (VSQG) consolidation with LQG of same company.(R315-262-14 & 17)
- Episodic generation (R315-262-230 thru 233)
- LQG Waiver from 50-foot rule (R315-262-17)
