Training for Manifest Signers

- o Hazardous Waste Shipping is Jointly Regulated.
- If you are signing a hazardous waste manifest you are offering hazardous materials for transportation.
- When you sign you are <u>CERTIFYING</u> (49 CFR §172.204)

SQG Training R315-262-16(b)(9)(iii)

The small quantity generator shall ensure that all employees are thoroughly familiar with proper waste handling and emergency procedures, relevant to their responsibilities during normal facility operations and emergencies.




SQG Training Content

- Site-specific emergency response training
- 2. RCRA Hazardous Waste training
- 3. DOT HazMat shipping training
 - general awareness,
 - function-specific, safety

LQG Training R315-262-17(a)(7)

- Facility personnel must complete training within 6 months & annual refresher
- Must include hazardous waste management procedures
- Employees must be able respond to emergencies



Training Contractors

- Contractors working at LQG sites fall under the R315-260-10 definition of "facility personnel."
- At a minimum, train contractors on: evacuation routes, emergency communications/alarms, and proper hazardous waste handling procedures.

Universal Waste Training

- A small quantity handler of universal waste shall inform all employees who handle or have responsibility for managing universal waste.
- The information shall describe proper handling and emergency procedures appropriate to the type(s) of universal waste handled at the

Frequent Training Violations

- 1. Manifest signers not trained (SQGs and LQGs)
- 2. Training not documented (SQGs)
- 3. No job descriptions or descriptions don't include hazardous waste duties (LQGs)
- 4. Emergency coordinators and/or responders not included in training plan (LQGs)
- 5. Contractors not included in training plan (LQGs)
- 6. Type & amount of initial and continuing training not specified (LQGs)
- 7. Annual refresher training not completed or not completed in a timely manner (LQGs)
