NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT ON EnergySolutions LLC Mixed Waste Facility

Treatment Variance Request for Wastes Containing Uranium Extraction Residue

The public comment period to receive comments on these Treatment Variance Requests will commence on February 10, 2021 and end on March 11, 2021. A public hearing on these issues will be held upon request.

The Mixed Waste Facility proposes to receive cemented monoliths containing uranium extraction residuals. This material retains hazardous waste codes for barium, cadmium, chromium, lead, and spent solvents. The generator has encapsulated the waste in concrete for safety and security reasons.

Energy*Solutions* proposes to receive this waste for macroencapsulation in the Mixed Waste Landfill Cell rather than chemical stabilization, as required. This request is based on the fact that the waste has already been encapsulated in concrete at the generator's facility. Treating this waste by the required method would mean grinding the waste and potentially exposing workers to unnecessary contamination.

The proposed treatment will further encapsulate the waste and protect it from contact with precipitation, thereby decreasing the potential of leaching and would ensure protection of public health and the environment.

EnergySolutions approximates it may receive up to 1,000 cubic feet of this waste.

Final disposal of the waste will occur in the Mixed Waste Disposal Cell at the EnergySolutions Mixed Waste Facility.

The 30-day public comment period to receive comments on the proposed action will commence on February 10, 2021 and end on March 11, 2021. A public hearing on these issues will be held upon request.
