



Waste Tire Recycler Registration Application

Pursuant to Utah Administrative Code R315-320-4, to obtain a waste tire recycler registration number and approval to act as a waste tire recycler, a recycler shall submit the following information on this form with accompanying required documentation and fee payment to the Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste. Registration runs from January 1 to December 31 and must be renewed each year.

Part II General Information			
A. Area Served: The Waste Tire Recycling Act in Subsection 19-6-809(3) requires that for a waste tire recycler to be eligible for partial reimbursement under the Act, the recycler must, in cooperation with tire retailers or transporters, establish a reasonable schedule to remove waste tires, in sufficient quantities to allow for economic transportation, from any municipality in the State. A waste tire recycler must be able to provide information that will support the contention that this requirement has been met.			

B. Working Capacity of Recycling Process: Attach a detailed description of the recycling process (e.g., burning as a fuel in cement kiln) including the average number of tires that can be recycled in the process on a daily basis and the maximum annual capacity of the process. The description must include the existence or status of any equipment used in the process, the existence or status of any contracts required, and the existence or status of any local permits needed for the operation. (A recycling certificate cannot be granted to a facility that does not meet the definition of recycler in UCA 19-6-803(20) and where equipment and contracts are not in place)

Registration Fee: The Utah Legislature, in the Annual Appropriation Act, has approved an annual registration fee of \$100.00 for registration of a waste tire transporter. The fee must be submitted with this application. Note Utah Administrative Code R315-320-5(7)(b) allows a waiver of the registration fee for a waste tire transporter that has a valid registration from a local health department within Utah.
