Model Delegation of RSO's Authorities

The following model provides one method of complying with the necessary information to be submitted to the DWMRC to allow the DWMRC to interact with the company's Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) for activities related to the radioactive materials license and is not intended to be the only means for providing the necessary information.

For the purposes of this document or any other document used for delegating authority to the RSO, the term, "management" refers to the Chief Executive Officer or other individual having the authority to sign legal documents for the licensee to manage, direct, or administer the licensee's activities.

IMPORTANT: It is important to remember that although certain duties and responsibilities have been delegated to the RSO through the Delegation of Authority, the <u>ultimate responsibility</u> for compliance with the conditions of the radioactive materials license and the requirements in the Utah Administrative Code applicable to the activities authorized under the radioactive materials license remains with the licensee.

<u>Delegation of Authority</u> (Must be on the Licensee's Letterhead)
