3.1 Collection Centers- Types A & B

Type A

- Accepts, aggregates, stores used oil collected from household do-it-yourselfers
- Quantity cannot exceed 5 gallons per visit

Type B

- Same as Type A, and:
- Accepts, aggregates, stores used oil collected from farmers
- Quantity cannot exceed 55 gallons per visit

Type A & B


- Do not accept used oil from generators other than those specified
- Classified as DIYer used oil collection centers and may be reimbursed as described in R315-15-

3.1 UOCC Type A & B Requirements

- Comply with the generator standards in R315-15-2.
- Register with DWMRC to manage used oil as a used oil collection center
- Keep records of used oil that is collected

3.2 Collection Centers- Type C

Self-Transportation of Small Amounts to Approved Collection Centers

1. Vehicle must be owned by the generator or an employee of the generator
1. No more than 55 gallons at any time
1. Transported to a registered or permitted collection center

Type C

- Accepts, aggregates, stores used oil collected from used oil generators including:
 - Household DIYers
 - *Not exceeding 5 gallons per visit
 - *Reimbursable
 - Farmers
 - *Not exceeding 55 gallons per visit
 - *Reimbursable
 - Businesses
 - *Not exceeding 55 gallons per visit
 - *NOT Reimbursable

3.2 Collection Centers- Type D




A Type D used oil collection center is any site or facility that only accepts/aggregates and stores used oil collected from used oil generators regulated under R315-15-2 who bring used oil to the collection center in shipments of no more than 55 gallons under the provisions of R315-15-2.5(a).

Type D used oil collection centers do not qualify for reimbursement.

3.2 UOCC Type C & D Requirements

- Comply with the generator standards in R315-15-2.
 - Register with DWMRC to manage used oil.
 - Keep records of used oil received from off-site sources and transported from the collection center.
- *Not Including used oil generated on-site*

3.3 Aggregation Points ---

A used oil aggregation point is any site or facility that accepts, aggregates, or stores used oil collected only from other used oil generation sites owned or operated by the owner or operator of the aggregation point.

- Owners or operators of all used oil aggregation points shall comply with the generator standards in R315-15-2.
- Used oil is transported to the aggregation point in shipments of 55 gallons or less under the provisions of R315-15-2.5.

If an aggregation point accepts used oil from household DIYers, it must register with the Director as a DIYer collection center (type A or B) and comply with the DIYer standards in Section R315-15-3.1.

(Type A & B)

If an aggregation point accepts used oil from other generators it must register with the Director as a generator collection center (Type C or D) and comply with the standards in R315-15-3.2.

(Type C & D)

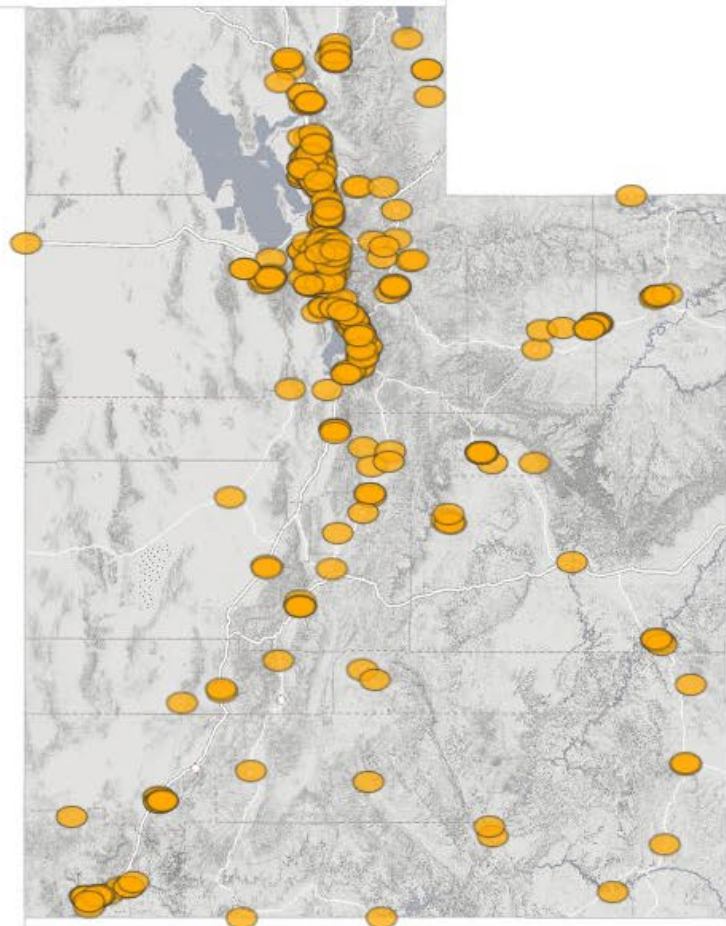
