NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT Site Management Plan Canyon Creek Phase Ten L.L.C., 10.345 acre tract, Lot 1, Canyon Creek Shopping Center Subdivision, Spanish Fork, Utah

The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control invites comment from the public on a draft Site Management Plan (SMP) developed by Canyon Creek Phase Ten L.L.C, 2733 East Parleys Way, Suite 300, Salt Lake City, Utah. The SMP includes activity use limitations and future actions needed to manage the soil and groundwater contamination present at the Spanish Fork site. The property is also required to implement an Environmental Covenant that will be recorded in the Utah County Recorder's Office, after approval of the SMP.

The public comment period to receive comments on the SMP will commence on January 11, 2019 and ends on February 11, 2019. A public hearing may be held if, within 15 days of publication of this notice, a request is made to the Director in writing which meets the requirements of UAC R315-311-3.
