The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control is seeking public comment on a request for a treatment variance received from the Clean Harbors Grassy Mountain Facility, LLC for a waste with a hazardous waste code D009. The waste stream is spray dryer residue from the Clean Harbors Aragonite facility that contains mercury.
