On March 31, 2022, Clean Harbors Grassy Mountain (CHGM) applied to renew their RCRA Part B Operating Permit, which was due to expire on September 28, 2022. The Director's staff has evaluated the permit renewal application as required by Section 19-6-108 of the Utah Solid and Hazardous Waste Act and R315-101 through 273 of the Utah Administrative Code (UAC). Based on this evaluation, the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control has prepared a Draft of the new RCRA Part B Operating Permit.

A 45-day public comment period to receive comments on the draft permit will commence on Thursday, June 15, 2023, and ends at 5 p.m. on Monday, July 31, 2023. A public hearing has been scheduled at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, July 18, 2023, at the Multi-Agency State Office Building, (UDEQ Board Conference Room #1015), located at 195 North 1950 West, Salt Lake City, Utah 84116.
