The Permit application has been reviewed by the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control for compliance with the Solid Waste Management Rules and a draft permit has been prepared. The Director is soliciting comments on the draft permit prior to final action by the Director.

The public comment period to receive comments on the permit renewal will commence on December 18, 2020 and end on January 18, 2021.
