Former Parish Chemical – Proposed Site Management Plan UTD 072988173

The former Parish Chemical facility located at 145 North Geneva Road, Vineyard, Utah has recently completed the approved corrective actions at the site which consisted of excavation and disposal of approximately 170 tons of soils impacted with hazardous heavy metal contaminants consisting primarily of arsenic and total lead.

The proposed Site Management Plan for the facility is proposing future activity and land use limitations consisting of prohibition of utilizing the shallow groundwater at the site and prohibiting any residential land use development on the impacted property.

The public comment period to receive comments on the proposed Site Management Plan will commence on March 22, 2021 and end on April 20, 2021.
