The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control is proposing to enter into a Stipulation and Consent Order (SCO) with Out of the Woods Custom Cabinetry, Inc. (OOTW) to resolve a Notice of Violation (NOV) Number 2202016 issued on March 24, 2022.

A 30-day public comment period to receive comments on the SCO will commence on Monday, October 31, 2022 and end at 5 p.m. on Tuesday, November 29, 2022.
