The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control invites public comment on a draft Site Management Plan (SMP) for High Mountain Forest Products, formerly Tool Design Engineering & Manufacturing. The draft SMP proposes long-term site management for residual metal impacted soils at the site.

A 30-day public comment period to receive comments on the draft SMP will commence on Monday, November 21, 2022 and end at 5 p.m. on Tuesday, December 20, 2022.
