## Ninigret Technology Park, Salt Lake City, Utah Draft Site Management Plans UTD009073800

The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control is seeking public comment on four draft Site Management Plans (SMPs) for Ninigret Technology Park (Ninigret) located at 2550 Andrew Avenue and 2950 Andrew Avenue, Salt Lake City, Utah. These SMPs include: the Eastern Alum Ponds SMP, Plant Site SMP, Pyrite SMP, and Western Ponds SMP. The Ninigret sites have been redeveloped and groundwater monitoring requirements have been met. Therefore, the SMPs have been revised to reflect redevelopment and remove language referencing groundwater monitoring requirements.

A 30-day public comment period to receive comments on the four Site Management Plans will commence on Monday, July 11, 2022 and end at 5 p.m. on Tuesday, August 9, 2022.
