NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT ON
Promontory Point Landfill Class V Application Decision

Promontory Point Resources, LLC has submitted a permit application for the existing non-commercial Promontory Point Landfill, that is a Class I landfill located within Box Elder County, to be reclassified to a commercial Class V landfill. The application has been reviewed by the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control for compliance with the Utah Solid and Hazardous Waste Act and applicable administrative rules, and a Statement of Basis detailing the Director's intent has been prepared. The Director is soliciting comments on the Statement of Basis prior to final action.

A 45-day public comment period to receive comments on the Statement of Basis detailing the Director's intent will commence on Thursday, February 23, 2023, and end at 5 p.m. on Monday, April 10, 2023. A public hearing has been scheduled from 4:00 pm – 5:00 pm on Monday, March 27th in DEQ Board Room #1015, of the Multi-Agency State Office Building, located at 195 North 1950 West Salt Lake City, UT 84116.
