NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT ON
RNI Ace Disposal Oil and Gas Exploration and Production Waste Landfill

RNI Ace Disposal has submitted a permit application to construct and operate an Oil and Gas Exploration and Production Waste Landfill ten miles southwest of Vernal, Uintah County. Oil and Gas Exploration and Production Waste landfills accept only oil and gas exploration and production waste. The permit application has been reviewed by the Director for compliance with the Solid Waste Management Rules and a draft permit has been prepared by the Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control. The Director is soliciting comments on the permit renewal application and the draft permit in relation to their compliance with the Solid Waste Management Rules. R315-311-3 of the Utah Administrative Code provides for a public comment period to receive comments on the application and draft permit prior to final action by the Director.

A 30-day public comment period to receive comments on the draft permit will commence on Thursday, December 8, 2022, and will end at 5 p.m. on Friday, January 6, 2023.

All documents included in comments must be submitted in pdf format or as ASCII (text) files.
