Dear Mr. Keim:

Your Generator Site Access Permit, administered by the Utah Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control, will expire in October 2021. If you wish to renew your permit, please submit your application and the application fee 30 days before the permit's expiration date.

Please note that the application form requires the precise legal name of the applicant (Permittee) and the state in which the entity was formed or incorporated. If the Permittee is a governmental agency, that information should be provided on the application form. The Permittee should be the legal entity (whether a corporate entity or a governmental agency) that is responsible for compliance with the Utah Radiation Control Rules for waste shipments destined for disposal in the State of Utah, regardless of whether the Permittee is the actual generator of the waste. The identity of the Permittee should match the "SHIPPER" name that is to be listed on the standard radioactive waste manifest form.
