NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT ON  
Madsen Class IV Construction/Demolition Debris Landfill

Madsen Construction has submitted a renewal permit application to the Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control for the Madsen Class IV Landfill. This private landfill will be used exclusively to dispose of nonhazardous construction waste associated with the activities of Madsen Construction Company and limited to construction debris, inert soils, yard waste, and petroleum-contaminated soils as allowed by UAC R315-315-8(3). The landfill is located approximately 0.5 miles east of the town of Gunnison, Utah.

The proposed permit application has been reviewed and has been determined to be complete and in compliance with the Utah Solid Waste Permitting and Management Rules. The permit allows the Landfill to continue to operate for ten years after it has been approved.

The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control is currently seeking public comment on this draft permit.

A 30-day public comment period to receive comments on this draft permit will commence on February 3, 2022 and end at 5 p.m. on March 4, 2022.
