Tooele Army Depot South
Hazardous Waste Management Unit 38 Closure Certification Report**

The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control invites comment from the public regarding the Closure Certification Report for Hazardous Waste Management Unit (HWMU) 38 at Tooele Army Depot South (TEADS) located near Stockton, Utah. HWMU 38 was used to open burn munitions recovered during a remedial action. All waste and contaminated soil has been removed and the area now qualifies for residential use or No Further Action (NFA) as defined in UAC R315-101.

The 30-day public comment period for the TEADS Closure Certification Report begins August 21, 2019 and ends September 19, 2019. A public hearing may be held if, within 15 days of publication of this notice, a request is made to the Director in writing which meets the requirements of UAC R315-311-3.
