NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT ON Draft Renewal Permit Weber County Class VI Landfill

Weber County Corporation has submitted a permit renewal application to continue to operate its Class VI Landfill at 10485 West 900 South, Ogden, Weber County, Utah. The landfill will continue to receive non-hazardous construction and demolition solid waste. The renewal permit application has been reviewed by the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control for compliance with the Solid Waste Management Rules and a draft permit has been prepared by the Director of Waste Management and Radiation Control. The Director is soliciting comments on the permit application and the draft permit in relation to their compliance with the Solid Waste Management Rules. R315-311-3 of the Utah Administrative Code provides for a public comment period to receive comments on the renewal application and draft permit prior to final action by the Director.

The public comment period to receive comments on the draft permit will commence on April 28, 2021 and end on May 27, 2021.
