Class IIIb Landfill Permit Renewal for the Weber Basin Water Conservancy Water Treatment Mono-landfill

The Weber Basin Water Conservancy District has applied for a permit renewal for their existing Water Treatment Mono-landfill located at 2805 East 6600 South in Uintah Utah, Weber County. The Permit renewal application was received by the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control on January 15, 2021 (DSHW-2021-000910). The application was found to be complete and in compliance with the existing rules and regulations of the Utah Code and the Utah Administrative Rules. A draft permit has been prepared and the Director is now seeking public comment on the draft permit.

A 30-day public comment period to receive comments on the permit renewal will commence on May 24, 2021 and end at 5 p.m. on June 22, 2021.
