Tri-State Oil Reclaimers Inc. UTR000013953

The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control invites public comment on the modification of a Used Oil Processor Permit (UOP-0172) for Tri-State Oil Reclaimers Inc. The proposed modification would allow Tri-State Oil Reclaimers Inc. to move its used oil tank farm approximately six-tenths of a mile (0.6 mile) north within the same property (Keigley Quarry) on which it is currently permitted. Under the modified permit, Tri-State Oil Reclaimers Inc. would be allowed to store an additional 42,000 gallons of used oil in two additional tanks. The proposed modified permit also updates the Permittee name and permit contact information.

A fifteen-day public comment period to receive comments on the permit modification will commence on Thursday, February 15, 2024, and end at 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 29, 2024.
