The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control invites public comment on the modification of a Used Oil Processor Permit (UOP-0095) for Thermo Fluids Inc. The proposed modification updates the facility piping and instrumentation diagram to reflect new piping for proposed storage of oily water in existing tanks at the facility.

A fifteen-day public comment period to receive comments on the proposed modification to Thermo Fluids Inc.'s Used Oil Processor Permit will commence on Thursday, February 29, 2024, and end at 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 14, 2024.
