The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control is proposing to enter into STIPULATION AND CONSENT ORDER Number 2202018 (SCO) with Simons Petroleum LLC (Simons) to resolve Notice of Violation Number 2109004 (NOV) issued to Simons on January 12, 2022, regarding used oil transfer facility violations documented during a May 20, 2021, compliance evaluation inspection at the Simons facility in Vernal, Utah. The proposed SCO includes a penalty of \$21,963.00, of which \$9,888.00 is to be deferred and waived pending future compliance.

A thirty-day public comment period to receive comments on the Simons SCO will commence on Thursday, March 21, 2024 and end at 5 p.m. on Friday, April 19, 2024.
