Sale of New Oil

Utah Code 19-6-714. Recycling fee on sale of oil.

A recycling fee of \$.04 per quart or \$.16 per gallon is imposed upon the first sale in Utah by a lubricating oil vendor of lubricating oil. The lubricating oil vendor shall collect the fee at the time the lubricating oil is sold.

Utah Code §19-6-720

Priorities

Utah Code §19-6-720 authorizes the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control to award grants, as funds are available, for the following:

- (a) Used oil collection centers;
- (b) Used oil collection events;
- (c) Curbside used oil collection programs, including costs of retrofitting trucks, curbside containers, and other costs of collection programs; and
- (d) Public education programs and outreach
