# April 29, 2021 Utah Wastewater Operator Certification Exams



## **Session Reservation Required**

Due to the continuing group gathering limitations, the April 29, 2021 testing sessions will be "by appointment only" at locations where social distancing requirements can be met. They will be scheduled for either "morning" or "afternoon" depending on the hosting location on a first-come, first-served basis for completed applications.

- Orem (Water Reclamation) Maximum 12 each session
- Price (Price River Water Improvement Dist.) Maximum 12 each session
- Salt Lake City (DWQ offices) Maximum 30 each session
- Sandy (Cottonwood Imp. Dist.) Maximum 12 each session
- St. George area (Ash Creek SSD, Hurricane) Maximum 20 (afternoon only)
- Vernal (Ashley Valley W&SID) Maximum 8 (afternoon only)
