Public notice of modification to the Cedar City Ordinance related to the Pretreatment Program delegated by the Division of Water Quality

**PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE**

The purpose of this public notice is to solicit public comment regarding the Cedar City Ordinance for implementing the pretreatment program. This change is considered a substantial modification of the Cedar City Pretreatment Program. The ordinance has been reviewed and found to meet the requirements of R317-8-8. Once the public notice period and comment process is complete it is the intent of the Division of Water Quality to formally approve the modifications to the ordinance for implementation by Cedar City.

**BACKGROUND**

Cedar City has modified the ordinance for implementing the pretreatment program due to comments and requirements by the Division of Water Quality. The changes could impact industrial dischargers discharging to the Cedar City publicly owned treatment works.

A public hearing can be requested although must be filed during the comment period which will end on **June 8, 2020**. A request for a public hearing must be filed per the requirements of 40 CFR 403.11. After considering public comments the director may approve, revise or abandon the revisions to the ordinance. The director will not publish a notice of decision provided the ordinance will be approved without any changes and no comments are received during the public comment period.
