PUBLIC NOTICE OF VARIANCE TO TBPEL IMPLEMENTATION DATE

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

The purpose of this public notice is to declare the State of Utah's intention to grant a variance to the implementation deadline for Technology Based Phosphorus Effluent Limit compliance to the Central Weber Sewer Improvement District. Pursuant to *UAC R317-1-3.3* and corresponding provisions of the Utah Water Quality Act.

BACKGROUND

The Central Weber Sewer Improvement District (CWSID) serves the communities of Farr West, Hooper, Harrisville, North Ogden, Ogden, Pleasant View, Marriott-Slaterville, Riverdale, South Ogden, West Haven, South Weber, Washington Terrace, Weber County, and portions of Roy, Plain City, and Uintah. CWSID submitted a variance request, dated December 26, 2017 to the Utah Division of Water Quality "DWQ", seeking a variance to the TBPEL implementation date. The Variance Request is based on the fact that CWSID is in the process of designing and constructing improvements to the Facility to meet TBPEL requirements, however, such improvements cannot be completed prior to January 1, 2020, despite CWSID's diligence.
