Division of Water Quality Utah Department of Environmental Quality Public Notice of Intent to Issue a Ground Water Discharge Permit Permit No. UGW27006

Purpose of Public Notice

The Utah Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) is soliciting comments on the request to renew a ground water discharge permit as described below. The ground water discharge permit is issued by the Director of the Division of Water Quality under authority of the Utah Water Quality Act, Section 19-5-106(g) Utah Code Ann. 1953, as amended and Utah Administrative Code R317-6. Under Section 19-1-301.5, effective May 8, 2012, a person who wishes to challenge a Permit Order may only raise an issue or argument during an adjudicatory proceeding that was raised during the public comment period and was supported with sufficient information or documentation to enable the Director to fully consider the substance and significance of the issue. The Delta Milk Company has requested renewal of the ground water discharge permit to cover operation of a dairy located approximately 6 miles southeast of Delta in Millard County. The dairy operation flushes manure from the barns using recycled plate cooler water. The liquid fraction is stored in wastewater retention lagoons. Both liquid and solid fraction is applied to fields at the appropriate agronomic rate in accordance with a Certified Nutrient Management Plan. The permit requires semi-annual sampling of ground water monitoring wells to monitor performance of the wastewater lagoons.
