## PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

The purpose of this public notice is to declare the state of Utah's intention to renew a Utah Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (UDPES) Permit under authority of the Utah Water Quality Act, Section 19-5-104 and 107, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended. Said "permit" refers to UPDES Permit and the Fact Sheet and Statement of Basis (including the total maximum daily loads (TMDL's)) if applicable, as per Section 303 (d) of the Federal Clean Water Act (CWA).

### **BACKGROUND**

Over the last 5 years, Emery Mine has only had need to discharge from Outfall 003. There has not been enough accumulated storm water to discharge from any of the storm water settling ponds for over 15 years. Historically, discharges from this facility have been exclusively comprised of intercepted groundwater from the mine area. Outfall 008 has not been developed to date. However, this outfall is identified in a plan for future activities maintained by the Division of Oil Gas and Mining. Therefore, it is included as an outfall in this renewal permit. As the mine has been developed, outfall 005, which previously only received storm water, has now been redesigned to receive and discharge intercepted mine water.
