PUBLIC NOTICE OF RENEWAL OF UPDES PERMIT

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

The purpose of this public notice is to declare the state of Utah's intention to MODIFY a Utah Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (UPDES) Permit under authority of the Utah Water Quality Act, Section 19-5-104 and 107, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended. Said "permit" refers to UPDES Permit and the Fact Sheet and Statement of Basis (including the total maximum daily loads (TMDL's)) if applicable, as per Section 303 (d) of the Federal Clean Water Act (CWA).

BACKGROUND

The permit is being modified to add a new discharge location to the current permit. The facility has requested a new discharge location to assist Spanish Fork City when supplying water to the pressurized irrigation system. The current discharge location requires the facility to open and close over 50 valves twice a year to convey water to the current discharge location. Moving the discharge location will reduce that number to two valves. The existing outfall to the Spanish Fork River will be renamed to Outfall 002a and the new outfall will be named Outfall 002b. The compliance point for both of these locations will be the Spanish Fork GAC building.
