PUBLIC NOTICE OF VARIANCE TO TBPEL IMPLEMENTATION DATE

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

The purpose of this public notice is to declare the State of Utah's intention to grant a variance to the implementation deadline for Technology Based Phosphorous Effluent Limit (TBPEL) compliance for Fairview City pursuant to UAC R317-1-3.3 and the corresponding provisions of the Utah Water Quality Act.

BACKGROUND

The Department of Water Quality adopted UAC R317-1-3.3, Technology-Based Phosphorus Effluent Limit (TBPEL) Rule in 2014. The TBPEL requires that all non-lagoon wastewater treatment works discharging wastewater to surface waters of the state provide treatment processes which would produce effluent less than or equal to an annual mean of 1.0 mg/L for total phosphorus. This TBPEL was to be achieved by January 1, 2020, unless facility was granted a permit variance. Fairview City requested two permit variances for the Fairview City Wastewater Treatment Plant based on the fact that they in the process of designing and constructing improvements to the facility to meet TBPEL requirements.
