PUBLIC NOTICE OF REISSUANCE OF A UPDES PERMIT

**PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE**

The purpose of this public notice is to declare the state of Utah's intention to reissue a Utah Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (UPDES) permit under authority of the Utah Water Quality Act, Section 19-5-106 and 107, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended. Said "permit" refers to UPDES permit and the statement of basis (including the total maximum daily loads (TMDL's)) if applicable, as per Section 303 (d) of the Federal Clean Water Act (CWA).

**BACKGROUND**

The facility withdraws wash water by water right from three ponds known as West Pond, Middle Pond and Main Pond. These ponds are comprised of irrigation water. Water is pumped from the main pond to the wash plant. After its use in the wash plant, it is discharged to the first of two settling basins. It is then transferred to a second settling basin. This water is recycled from the second settling basin back to the Main Pond. Outfall 001 drains the Main Pond from a pipe located deep in the pond. A second discharge point (002) is located on the Main Pond to handle any excess water in the system.
