PUBLIC NOTICE TO REISSUE A UPDES PERMIT

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

The purpose of this public notice is to declare the state of Utah's intention to reissue a Utah Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (UDPES) Permit under authority of the Utah Water Quality Act, Section 19-5-104 and 107, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended. Said "permit" refers to UPDES Permit and the Fact Sheet and Statement of Basis (including the total maximum daily loads (TMDL's)) if applicable, as per Section 303 (d) of the Federal Clean Water Act (CWA).

BACKGROUND

The design capacity of the facility is 1.0 MGD. The current population of Kamas is approximately 1,900. The treatment facility was originally designed for an influent organic loading of 420 lbs/day of Biochemical Oxygen Demand (BOD) and 375 lbs/day of Total suspended solids (TSS). Since the facility was built, it has added additional aerators to their system. With this addition, the facility can now treat 1,750 lbs of BOD per day with a population equivalent of approximately 4,000. The wastewater lagoon is located approximately one-quarter (0.25) mile northwest of Kamas, Utah in Summit County.
