

**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
**Kellerstrass Ogden Bulk Oil Plant Corrective Action Plan**  
**1500 West 2550 South**  
**Ogden, Utah**

***Notice of Corrective Action***

A site investigation on the north-east portion of Kellerstrass Ogden Bulk Plant property identified gasoline-impacted groundwater. The release was reported to the Division of Water Quality (DWQ) on May 17, 2019.

A Corrective Action Plan (CAP) has been developed to properly address the gasoline-impacted groundwater.

***Site Description***

The property is located at 1500 West 2550 South, Ogden, Utah. The facility is currently a bulk gasoline and oil storage, delivery site, gasoline dispenser facility and office complex. A site investigation has been conducted and petroleum groundwater contamination has been identified.

***Cleanup Plan***

The selected corrective action approach includes the following tasks:

1. Install 8 inch recovery well.
2. Install and operate a temporary tank sparging system to remove petroleum constituents from the groundwater. Sparging system will be operational until the groundwater meets the Initial Screening levels.
3. Obtain a UPDES permit and authorization from Ogden City Storm Drain Department to discharge treated water to the Ogden City Storm Drain System.

***Public Comment***

The public is invited to review and comment on the proposed Corrective Action plan (CAP). At the conclusion of the comment period, the CAP will either be approved as presented or modified based on public feedback.
