PUBLIC NOTICE TO REISSUE A UPDES PERMIT

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

The purpose of this public notice is to declare the State of Utah's intention to issue a Utah Pollution Discharge Elimination System (UPDES) Permit under authority of the Utah Water Pollution Control Act, Section 19-5-104(9) and 107(2), Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended. Said "permit" refers to the UPDES Permit and the Fact Sheet Statement of Basis (including Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDL's)) if applicable, as per Section 303(d) of the Federal Clean Water Act (CWA).

BACKGROUND

NRP Jones, LLC (NRP) facility produces finished high pressure rubber hoses including hoses wrapped with nylon fabric and wire cable. The production at the facility is dependent on the various markets NRP supports. The standard industrial classification (SIC) codes for NRP is 3052 for rubber and plastics hose and belting, and 5085 for industrial supplies. NRP uses culinary water from the city of Nephi for non-contact cooling then discharges to the Nephi Irrigation Ditch. The Nephi Irrigation Ditch is utilized by local farmers and ranchers for irrigation.
