PUBLIC NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF AN UPDES BIOSOLIDS PERMIT

**PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE**

The purpose of this public notice is to declare the State of Utah's intention to issue a Utah Pollution Discharge Elimination System (UPDES) Permit under authority of the Utah Water Pollution Control Act, Section 19-5-104(9) and 107(2), Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended. Said "permit" refers to the UPDES Permit and the Fact Sheet Statement of Basis (including Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDL's)) if applicable, as per Section 303(d) of the Federal Clean Water Act (CWA)].

**BACKGROUND**

Waste and Water Logistics, LLC (WWL), a.k.a. iGOTPOOP.COM services septic tanks and systems, provides portable toilets, and hauls wastes for the public. WWL is the new owner/operator for the Nielson Construction Landfill and wants to dewater and dispose septage at the landfill.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Public comments are invited any time prior to the deadline of the close of business on **October 10, 2021**. During the public comment period provided under R317-8-6.5, any interested person may submit written comments on the draft permit and may request a public hearing, if no hearing has already been scheduled. A request for a public hearing shall be in writing and shall state the nature

All comments will be considered in making the final decision and shall be answered as provided in R317-8-6.12. After considering public comments on the Permit, the Division of Water Quality may issue, or revise it.
