PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO SOLICIT PUBLIC COMMENT REGARDING NORTH DAVIS SEWER DISTRICT'S INTENTION TO MODIFY ITS PRETREATMENT REGULATIONS REGARDING ITS SEWER ORDINANCE. THE SEWER ORDINANCE HAS BEEN REVIEWED BY THE DIVISION OF WATER QUALITY, ONCE THE PUBLIC NOTICE AND COMMENT PROCESS ARE COMPLETED; IT IS THE DIVISION OF WATER QUALITY'S INTENTION TO FORMALLY APPROVE THE MODIFICATIONS TO NORTH DAVIS SEWER DISTRICT'S SEWER ORDINANCE.

BACKGROUND

North Davis Sewer District has modified its sewer ordinance. The changes could impact industrial users discharging to the North Davis Sewer District publicly owned treatment works.

A public hearing can be requested but must be filed during the 30 day comment period which will end on August 24, 2015. A request for a public hearing must be filed per the requirement of 40 CFR 403.11. After considering public comments the Director may approve the sewer ordinance, revise it, or abandon it. The Director will not publish a notice of decision provided: North Davis Sewer District's ordinance will be approved without any changes to the ordinance and no comments are received during the public comment period.
