PUBLIC NOTICE OF REISSUANCE OF A UPDES PERMIT

**PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE**

The purpose of this public notice is to declare the State of Utah's intention to reissue a Utah Pollution Discharge Elimination System (UPDES) Permit under authority of the Utah Water Pollution Control Act, Section 19-5-104(9) and 107(2), Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended. Said "permit" refers to the UPDES Permit and the Fact Sheet Statement of Basis (including Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDL's)) if applicable, as per Section 303(d) of the Federal Clean Water Act (CWA).

**BACKGROUND**

Payson Power Project (Payson Power) is an electric generating facility operated by Utah Associated Municipal Power Systems (UAMPS) in Payson, Utah with an electric output of 141MW. The facility utilizes a gas-fired Combustion Turbine with a Heat Recovery Steam Generator and a steam turbine operating in a combined-cycle mode. Cooling water is obtained from the Payson City Wastewater Treatment Plant (Payson City). The treatment plant and Payson Power have an agreement to use the treatment plant's effluent for cooling water purposes. The flow enters the cooling tower and is discharged as a non-contact cooling water stream. The flow is 0.75MGD.
