PUBLIC NOTICE TO REISSUE A UPDES PERMIT

**PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE**

The purpose of this public notice is to declare the state of Utah's intention to reissue a Utah Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (UDPES) Permit under authority of the Utah Water Quality Act, Section 19-5-104 and 107, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended. Said "permit" refers to UPDES Permit and the Fact Sheet and Statement of Basis (including the total maximum daily loads (TMDL's) if applicable, as per Section 303 (d) of the Federal Clean Water Act (CWA)).

**BACKGROUND**

The Santaquin Water Reclamation Facility treats municipal wastewater in Santaquin City. The treatment facility has a design flow rate of 1.0 MGD and consists of a rotary drum screen, anoxic basins, aerobic basins, MBR treatment followed by ultraviolet disinfection prior to distribution in the pressurized irrigation system or discharge to the winter storage pond. SWRF has no means to discharge to surface water, but does collect, stabilize, and dispose of sludge.
