Public notice of modification to the Snyderville Basin Water Reclamation District Rules and Regulations and Local Limits related to the Pretreatment Program delegated by the Division of Water Quality

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

The purpose of this public notice is to solicit public comment regarding modifications to the Snyderville Basin Water Reclamation District Rules and Regulations and local limits for implementing the pretreatment program. This change is considered a substantial modification of the Snyderville Basin Water Reclamation District Pretreatment Program. The rules and regulations and local limits have been reviewed and found to meet the requirements of R317-8-8. Once the public notice period and comment process are completed it is the intent of the Division of Water Quality to formally approve the modifications for implementation by Snyderville Basin Water Reclamation District.

BACKGROUND

Snyderville Basin Water Reclamation District has modified the rules and regulations and local limits for implementing the pretreatment program due to comments and requirements by the Division of Water Quality. The changes could impact industrial dischargers discharging to the publicly owned treatment works, owned and operated by Snyderville Basin Water Reclamation District.

A public hearing can be requested although must be filed during the comment period which will end on **August 27, 2021**. A request for a public hearing must be filed per the requirements of 40 CFR 403.11. After considering public comments the director may approve, revise or abandon the revisions to the rules and regulations and/or local limits. The director will not publish a notice of decision provided the rules and regulations and local limits will be approved without any changes and no comments are received during the public comment period.
