**PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE**

The purpose of this public notice is to declare the State of Utah's intention to grant a variance to the Technology Based Phosphorus Effluent Limit compliance to Spanish Fork Wastewater Treatment Plant (Spanish Fork). Pursuant to UAC R317-1-3.3 and corresponding provisions of the Utah Water Quality Act.

**BACKGROUND**

Spanish Fork submitted a variance request, dated December 28, 2017 to the Utah Division of Water Quality "DWQ", seeking a variance to the TBPEL implementation. The Variance Request is based on the fact that Spanish Fork is in the process of determining the best viable option for improvements to the Facility to meet TBPEL requirements; however such improvements cannot be completed prior to January 1, 2020, despite Spanish Fork's diligence.
