### DIVISION OF WATER QUALITY UTAH DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY PUBLIC NOTICE OF A UPDES PERMIT MODIFICATION

#### **PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE**

The purpose of this public notice is to declare the state of Utah's intention to modify a Utah Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (UPDES) permit under authority of the Utah Water Pollution Control Act, Section 19-5-104(9) and 107(2), Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended. Said "permit" refers to the UPDES permit and the statement of basis (including total maximum daily loads (TMDL's) if applicable, as per section 303(d) of the Federal Clean Water Act (CWA).

#### **BACKGROUND**

TSSD's 2020 Draft Permit and Fact Sheet Statement of Basis (FSSOB) were posted for Public Notice from April 14, 2020, to May 14, 2020. On May 13, 2020, the Utah Division of Water Quality (DWQ) received a comment submitted by TSSD in regards to the TDS limit and monitoring requirements in the draft documents. TSSD requested this limit be removed and monitoring reduced to monthly. This comment was discussed, RP was run using DWQ data, and, based on these results, TSSD's request was granted. Note these changes are to be incorporated into the draft permit and FSSOB.
