BACKGROUND

Flaming Gorge submitted a variance request, dated November 10, 2017 to the Utah Division of Water Quality “DWQ”, seeking a variance to the TBPEL implementation. The Variance Request is based on the fact that the Facility contributes a small percent of the phosphorus loading in the Green River which is not listed as impaired due to any nutrient load.
