PUBLIC NOTICE OF RENEWAL OF UPDES PERMIT

**PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE**

The purpose of this public notice is to declare the State of Utah's intention to renew a Utah Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (UDPES) Permit under authority of the Utah Water Quality Act, Section 19-5-104 and 107, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended. Said "permit" refers to UPDES Permit and the Fact Sheet and Statement of Basis (including the total maximum daily loads (TMDL's)) if applicable, as per Section 303 (d) of the Federal Clean Water Act (CWA).

**BACKGROUND**

Weir Minerals NA SLC-Rubber Engineering (WMRE) is a molded rubber products manufacturer located in Salt Lake City, Utah with Standard Industrial Classification Code 3069 for rubber manufacturing. The WMRE manufacturing plant is approximately 50 years old and processes 11,000 - 13,700 pounds of rubber products per day on average. The discharge from the WMRE facility consists of storm water and both contact water and non-contact cooling water. Contact water and non-contact cooling water are used to control temperature in the manufacturing of rubber products. All discharges from WMRE are to the on-site storm water collection system, which connects to the South Salt Lake City storm drain inlet near 700 West, which then flows north discharging into Mill Creek.
